


City Clickers Workshops October 19th – Horfield Methodist Church BS7 8SN



The workshops this year will be held at:

Horfield Methodist Church
Churchways Avenue
Horfield BRISTOL
BS7 8SN

By car from M5 J16 (6 miles)
Take A38 direction City Centre, for approx 6 miles. As you approach Churchways Ave you will pass Horfield Common on your right, and as you start to come down the hill from the common, you will see the Methodist Church on your right by the Filton Road junction traffic lights.

By car from M32 J2 (2 miles)
Take B4469 Muller Road direction Horfield for approx 2 miles until you reach the T-junction with A38 at Horfield Common. Turn left onto A38 direction City Centre. After a few hundred yards, you start to

come down the hill from the common, and you will see the Methodist Church on your right by the Filton Road junction traffic lights.

By car from Bristol City Centre (2 miles)

Take A38 direction Gloucester, after approx 2 miles you will see the Methodist Church on your left by the Filton Road junction traffic lights.

Note – Parking: There is no car park at the church. Allow time to find parking in nearby residential streets.

Public Transport

The nearest railway stations are Bristol Temple Meads (near the city centre) and Bristol Parkway (to the north of the city on the London/Cardiff line)

By train to Bristol Temple Meads (2 miles)


Taxi: approx 10 mins, cost £10 ish
Bus: 8 or 9 to The Centre, then cross the Centre and take any bus 71, 73, 74, 75, 76, or 77 to Churchways Ave. Allow 40 mins for bus journeys.

By train to Bristol Parkway (4 miles).

Taxi: approx 15 mins, cost £15 ish
Bus: 73 direction The Centre, to Churchways Ave. Allow 40 mins for bus journey.

By coach / bus to Bristol Bus Station (1.5 miles)

Taxi: approx 10 mins, cost £9 ish
Bus: Leave bus station and find the bus stops outside 'Bristol Fashion' pub. Take any bus 71, 73, 74, 75, 76, 77 to Churchways Ave. Allow 25 mins for bus journey.
